The aim of the Entente Florale competition is to promote the greening of towns and villages; flowers, shrubs, green spaces and parks; development which is environmentally and ecologically sensitive; and education and communication initiatives which promote environmental awareness.

Entente Florale Europe began in 1975 as a small, floral competition between France and the United Kingdom. By 2008 the competition had changed and evolved into Europe's most prestigious environmental and horticultural competition. Currently there are ten participating countries: - Austria, Belgium, Czech Republic, Germany, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, the Netherlands, Slovenia and the United Kingdom.
