### Emissions of Volatile Organic Compounds from Organic Solvents Regulations 2002 (S.I. No. 543 of 2002)

In accordance with the provisions of article 26 of the Emissions of Volatile Organic Compounds from Organic Solvents Regulations 2002 (S.I. No. 543 of 2002);

Offaly County Council hereby certifies that, subject to the conditions and stated below, **Caroline Kelly T/a Master Clean, 1 Francis Street, Edenderry, Co. Offaly**, complies with the requirements of the Regulations.

The next application for annual certification of compliance under the Regulations is required no later than one year after the date of this certificate.

#### Conditions and Recommendations for Compliance:

This certificate is subject to the following:

1. Opening and closing stocks for the amount of solvent in the machine tanks and the weight of solvent in waste drums (kg), shall be taken at the beginning and end of each period of record keeping.
2. The scales used to weigh the loads shall be calibrated in-house periodically. Where any discrepancy is observed, a full calibration shall be undertaken.
3. Residue from the lint trap shall be treated as hazardous waste and shall not be disposed of via the domestic waste bin.
4. All waste products shall be stored in accordance with "The best practice guidelines for Dry Cleaners".
5. The opening on any container used to collect separator water shall be such as to avoid fugitive emissions from the container.
6. A maintenance programme and records shall be established for the maintenance of all dry-cleaning equipment on site.
7. All containers containing hazardous / Perc waste shall be labelled appropriately.
