1. CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES OF LAST MONTHLY MEETING

On the proposal of Cllr Brady and seconded by Cllr McDonnell the minutes of the Edenderry Town Council meeting held in April, 2012 were confirmed and signed.

2. ROADS PROGRAMME 2012

Damien ran through the roads programme relevant for Edenderry Town environs approved by area members March 2012. Dublin Road restoration is at tender stage and will hopefully commence in June.

- Bends on Clonmullen Lane
- One way system around by Col Perry St.
- Resurfacing Gilroy Ave, Castlevue Park and Assumption Road
- Junction at JKL St and Fr Paul Murphy St.
- Small part of Dublin Rd that has collapsed
- footpath at Aldi bus stop
- inner relief road
- road at cattle Mart
- footpath maintenance
- design for new school lay out
- Street light maintenance contract
- Street cleaning day after casual trading day
- Dog fouling – litter warden complimented, very pro active
- Litter from parked cars in square especially at the weekends a concern
- Street light contract

Damien replied

- he will meet the land owner to discuss bends at Clonmullen Lane
- one way will be used for diversions while work will be carried out however not going to be implemented on a long term basis
- programme is set for 2012 and it could be considered for 2013
- There were previous issues with placing a mini roundabout at junction so other than resurfacing this area nothing further will be carried out
- Collapsed part of road on Dublin Rd will be included in resurfacing
- Footpath at Aldi is an ongoing planning compliance issue and it is currently being looked into

- inner relief road dependant on developers
- not included in 2012 programme
- no budget in 2012 for footpath maintenance
- Part VIII is available, planning application is available for public viewing in planning section OCC
- Will look into street cleaning has very tight budget and limited resources
- Damien will get an update on public lighting contract for next meeting, he asked that everyone report any lights out of order to area office to assist monthly patrols.

3. R402 – EDENDERRY TO ENFIELD ROAD

Damien informed members that he has met with Kildare County Council and Coffey Construction to discuss impacts on Edenderry Area and town. They have agreed to monthly meetings and good links have been established. Updates re construction routes and progress reports to follow.
