MINUTES OF ANNUAL MEETING OF EDENDERRY TOWN COUNCIL
HELD ON WEDNESDAY 12TH JUNE, 2013,

Cllr Breen thanked those present for their help and support during her term as Cathaoirleach. All members complimented her on her year in the chair and wished her well.

1. ELECTION OF CATHAOIRLEACH

Cllr Foley was proposed by Cllr Murrin however, Cllr. Foley advised that due to personal reason he would not let his name go forward. Cllr. O'Neill was proposed by Cllr. Breen and seconded by Cllr. Foley. Cllr. Hogan was proposed by Cllr. Brady and seconded by Cllr. Cribbin. Cllr. Mc Donnell was proposed by Cllr.Leddin but he would not allowed his name to go forward as he wished to remain true to an agreement made 5 years ago. When a vote was taken Cllr. O'Neill was elected as Cathaoirleach, having five votes to four. He then received the Chain of office and took the chair.

All members wished Cllr O'Neill well in this the last year of Edenderry Town Council. Cllr O'Neill stated that it was his wish to work to the best of his abilities for the town, to develop the Promote Edenderry brochure and secure a 24 hour ambulance services for the town.

2. ELECTION OF LEAS CATHAOIRLEACH

Cllr Hogan was proposed by Cllr Brady and seconded by Cllr Cribbin. Cllr. Mc Donnell was proposed by Cllr. O'Neill and seconded by Cllr. Breen. Following a vote Cllr Mc Donnell was elected as Leas Cathaoirleach with five votes to four.

3. NOMINATION OF ONE REPRESENTATIVE TO IRISH BODIES MUTUAL INSURANCES LIMITED

Clr O'Neill was proposed by Cllr. Mc Donnell and seconded by Cllr. Breen. However it was then proposed by Cllr. Leddin and seconded by Cllr. Murrin that Cllr Hogan be nominated.

Cllr. O'Neill withdrew his name from the running and therefore Cllr Hogan was elected as representative to IPBMI
