PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to the requirements of the above, notice is hereby given of the following proposed scheme :-

Removal of Existing Steel Footbridge at Convent Road/Convent View, the construction of 2 no. Footbridges at Convent Road/Convent View and Bury Quay/Clontarf Road and the construction of a Boardwalk at Bury Quay, Tullamore, Co. Offaly

Tullamore Town Council proposes to erect two new pedestrian footbridges and a boardwalk along the Grand Canal in Tullamore. The proposal provides for:

1. The erection of a new footbridge (No.1) at Bury Quay/Clontarf Road,
2. The removal of the existing footbridge at Convent Road/Convent View, and its replacement with a proposed new footbridge (No.2).
3. A new boardwalk of length 67m at Bury Quay and associated landscaping. This will involve the pedestrianisation of Bury Quay and effective closure to vehicles with a revised traffic flow in the surrounding area. Proposals include the enhancement of the existing entrance to the Heritage Centre (note this building is a Protected Structure draft no. 23-294). This will take the form of paving and a glazed porch to accommodate ease of access for visitors.

Plans and particulars of the proposed development will be available for inspection at Tullamore Town Council, Town Hall, Cormac Street, Tullamore Co. Offaly during normal office hours from **Wednesday 24th February 2010 to Wednesday 14th April 2010.**

Written submissions or observations with respect to the proposed development, dealing with the proper and sustainable development of the area in which the development will be situated, must be made in writing before **4.00pm Friday 30th April 2010** to:
