2. REPORT FROM WATER & ENVIRONMENT SECTION.

J. Coleman gave an update on behalf of the Water Department. He outlined the following_-

Watermain Rehabilitation complete in Rhode and Geashill.

WM Rehab in Blundelwood approved. Section in Clonmullen lane applied for.

WM rehab in Croghan and Clonin approved in next tranche of funding.

Find and Fix operation ongoing in Edenderry.

Clonbullogue and Walsh Island Reservoirs are being designed.

WW Storage tanks installed at Walsh Island Waste Water Treatment plant.

C. Clancy, Environment Section gave an update on behalf of the Environment Section. She outlined the following:-

- Summary of the Litter and Waste Management Act,
- Different types of littering,
- Procedures involved in issuing fines,
- Who is responsible for litter offences

The Councillors welcomed the presentation and complimented the work that was being carried out. Cllr. Quinn expressed concern regarding bins that had been removed and queried whether they could be replaced. The Area Engineer confirmed that he would check the matter with the Area supervisor.
