Rita Ann Higgins was born and lives in Galway. She has published 12 books of poetry including Throw in the Vowels, Ireland is Changing Mother and Tongulish. She has also written essays and screenplays in Irish and English. In 2021 she received The Living Poets Society Award. In 1999, Rita Ann was Writer in Residence in Tullamore and edited a book Out the Clara Road featuring work by Offaly writers.

Simon Costello is from Tullamore, Co. Offaly. His poetry has recently been published in The Poetry Review, The Stinging Fly, The London Magazine, New England Review and The Moth among others. Saibhreas is an exhibition of works from Offaly County Council's municipal collection of visual art.
