Is éard atá sa fhorbairt ná:

Athfhorbairt Chlochar Naomh Seosamh, foirgnimh agus tailte coimhdeacha chun spás ilchuspóireach pobail/fiontair/foghlama a chruthú. Cuimsíonn an fhorbairt athchóiriú ar fhoirgneamh an chlochair agus ar an halla tionóil; tógáil síneadh nua dhá stór le staighre/ardaithoir trí stór inrochtana nua chuig foirgneamh an chlochair atá ann cheana féin; scartáil struchtúr réamhdhéanta, foirgneamh lasmuigh dhá stór, seomraí ranga fráma tairseach coincreite agus foirgnimh stóra; siúlóid líneach abhann a chruthú; bealach isteach nua d'fheithiclí ó Bhóthar Bhéal Átha Chomair, carrchlós agus na hoibreacha suímh go léir a bhaineann leis.

Tá Tuarascáil Scagthástála EIA ullmhaithe ag Comhairle Contae Uíbh Fhailí de réir cheanglais na Rialachán um Pleanáil agus Forbairt, 2001 (arna leasú). Ar bhonn na Tuarascála Scagtha seo, tá cinneadh déanta ag Comhairle Contae Uíbh Fhailí nach bhfuil aon dóchúlacht ann go mbeidh éifeachtaí suntasacha ar an gcomhshaol. Dá réir sin, socraíodh nach bhfuil EIA ag teastáil maidir leis an bhforbairt bheartaithe seo.

Is féidir le duine ar bith, laistigh de 4 (ceithre) seachtaine ó **thús Dé Chéadaoin 14ú Bealtaine 2025**, iarratas a dhéanamh chuig an mBord Pleanála ar chinneadh scagthástála maidir le cibé an mbeadh tionchar suntasach ag an bhforbairt bheartaithe seo ar an gcomhshaol nó nach mbeadh.

Tháinig an Scagadh Measúnaithe Cuí ar an gconclúid nach dócha go mbeadh éifeachtaí suntasacha ag an bhforbairt atá beartaithe ar aon láithreán Eorpach.

PART 8 OF THE PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS 2001 (AS AMENDED)

Notice is hereby given that Offaly County Council, proposes to carry out development, at St. Joseph's Convent, Main Street, Ferbane, Co. Offaly:

The development consists of:

The redevelopment of St. Joseph's Convent, ancillary buildings and grounds to incorporate a multi-purpose community/enterprise/learning space. The development consists of the refurbishment of the convent building and assembly hall; the construction of a new two-storey extension with a new accessible three-storey staircase/lift to the existing convent building; the demolition of a prefabricated structure, two-storey outbuilding, concrete portal frame classrooms and storage buildings; creation of a linear River walk amenity; a new vehicular access from the Ballycumber Road, parking provision and all associated site works.

Offaly County Council has prepared an EIA Screening Report in accordance with the requirements of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended). On the basis of this Screening Report, Offaly County Council has determined that there is no real likelihood of significant effects on the environment. Accordingly, it has been determined that EIA is not required in respect of this proposed development.

Any person may within **4 (four) weeks from beginning on Wednesday 14th May 2025**, apply to An Bord Pleanála for a screening determination as to whether this proposed development would be likely to have significant effects on the environment.

The development has been the subject of an Appropriate Assessment screening in accordance with the EU Habitats Directive and the Planning and Development Act 2000 as amended. The Appropriate Assessment Screening concluded that the proposed development would not be likely to give rise to significant effects on any European site.
