Offaly County Council has prepared an EIA Screening Report in accordance with the requirements of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended) and has determined that the proposed development would likely have no significant effects on the environment. (Article 120 of Planning and Development Regulations, amended 2018) Accordingly, it has been determined that an EIA is not required in respect of this proposed development. Any person may, within 4 weeks beginning on 1st February 2024, apply to An Bord Pleanála for a screening determination as to whether the development would be likely to have significant effects on the environment.

An Appropriate Assessment screening has been carried out by Offaly County Council and it has been determined that there would likely to be no significant impact on European sites from the proposed development.
