3. Regeneration/Project Updates

Andrew Murray, District Director, gave the following brief update to the Members in relation to the library development that construction should be awarded by the end of the year.

Swimming Pool tender closing date for submissions is end of month and there has been a lot of interest to date.

The Members welcomed the update and acknowledged the progress being made.

4. Area Issues/Updates/Roads Update



District Engineer Rory Moore and Executive Engineer Enda Daly gave a brief overview on the EMD Roads Programme for the year to date covering the following:

- Restoration Improvement (RIG) Schemes = 5 out of 10 schemes upon Regional roads and 18 out of 21 schemes upon Local roads completed to date.
- No (RMG) Restoration Maintenance Schemes completed to date, OCC Surface Dressing works due to commence mid-July (subject to plant availability & weather).
- EMD liaising with Bridge Consultant re Design for Repair required to Boyne Bridge R401-1
- 1 out of 5 2025 LIS Schemes within Edenderry MD completed to date.
- EMD Climate Adaptation Works At Rathvilla are nearing completion.

On the proposal of Cllr McDonnell, seconded by Cllr Cribbin; it was agreed to seek the installation of speed ramps, within The Sycamores estate and along Tyrrell's Lane serving various housing estates.

Discussions also took place regarding Offaly County Council Traffic Calming Policy and Edenderry MD works to collect data on speeds through towns & villages within the Municipal District.

A number of queries were raised by Members and were addressed by Mr. Moore &/or Mr. Daly. Where necessary, Mr. Moore / E. Daly advised they would investigate the issue(s) and revert to Members as soon as possible.

Cathaoirleach Cllr. Liam Quinn requested a letter to be sent to Irish Public Bodies for the statistics on the claims made for damages from roads within the Offaly region and the three other Midland Counties Laois, Westmeath and Longford.
