The Council is involved in monitoring surface and groundwaters.

The following information is based on data collected over a 6-year period from 2016 to 2021 under Ireland's national water quality monitoring programme, implemented from the Water Framework Directive (WFD) 2nd Cycle and the River Basin Management Plan.

The current WFD (3rd cycle) runs from 2022-2027.

The ecological status of 11 waterbodies improved




