HOUSING ADAPTATION GRANTS GUIDANCE NOTES – OFFALY COUNTY COUNCIL

There are three grants available for older people and disabled people to make adaptations to their home. The same application form is used for all three grants. All three grants are <u>means</u> <u>tested</u> which means your annual household income must be below certain limits to qualify.

1: Housing Adaptation Grant for People with a Disability (HGD): This grant is for people with a physical, sensory, mental health or intellectual disability. It is for big changes you need to make to your home. For full details see **page 3** of the application form. **Note:** Extensions will only be approved when all less costly and "fit for purpose" alternatives

Note: Extensions will only be approved when all less costly and "fit for purpose" alternatives have been considered and eliminated).

2: Mobility Aids Grant (MAG): This grant is for older people and/or people with a disability who find it hard to move around their home due to mobility issues. For full details see **page 5** of the application form.

3: Housing Aid for Older People (HOP): This grant is for people aged 66 years or more living in poor housing conditions to do essential repairs or improvements, so that they can continue to live in their own home. For full details see **page 6** of the application form. The works grant aided under the scheme include:

- help repair or replace the roof a letter from your insurance company stating the repairs are <u>not covered</u> under your policy <u>or</u> a letter confirming you have no insurance policy must be submitted with application.
- upgrade the electrical wiring *a report from an electrician describing the necessary repairs must be submitted with application*.(*Electrician must be registered with Safe Electric*)
- repair heating where it is broken or provide central heating where there is <u>no central</u> <u>heating</u>, or it is <u>broken beyond economic repair</u>. A report from a heating contractor describing the condition of the existing heating system must be submitted with application.
- repair or replace windows and doors replacement only for single glazed timber windows & doors that are deemed end of life and aluminium windows only. Repairs only for Double glazed windows that have not reached end of life. Please complete the attached form and submit with the application form

INCOME: Income details requirements are set out on **page 16** of the application form. Only the documents listed are accepted as proof of certified income. <u>www.welfare.ie</u>

LOCAL PROPERTY TAX: You are required to provide evidence of compliance with the Local Property Tax. A statement is available from Revenue online <u>www.revenue.ie</u> or you can contact Revenue (01) 7383626.

TAX CLEARANCE CERTIFICATE: You are required to provide tax clearance certificate is required for grant payments above €10,000. <u>www.revenue.ie</u> Revenue (01) 7383626

PAYMENT DETAILS: You will be required to provide bank/credit union details as part of your application. Details must be those of the **grant applicant** and not the contractors.

The local co-ordinators are supporting the older population over 65yrs in the Offaly County Council area, and will make an appointment to come and visit you in your home and assist you with this application form. This is a free service.

SEAI Grants – The Warmer Homes Scheme involves the installation of standard energy efficiency measures appropriate to the eligible household subject to SEAI survey budget allocation, and available capacity. The service is provided at no cost to the household and the measures that may be available under this scheme are:

- Attic insulation
- Draught proofing
- Lagging jackets
- Low energy light bulbs
- Cavity wall insulation
- Energy advice

This scheme is available to homes that are owner occupied and constructed before 2022.
