

SCHEDULE FOR NEWSPAPER NOTICE

SIGNIFICANT FURTHER INFORMATION OR REVISED PLANS

You are required to publish a notice in an approved newspaper containing as a heading the name of the Planning Authority, marked "Further Information" or "Revised Plans", as appropriate, and stating:-

- Name of Applicant _____
- Location, townland or postal address of the land or structure to which the application relates (as may be appropriate) _____
- The reference number of the application on the register _____
- That significant further information or revised plans as appropriate in relation to the application has or have been furnished to the Planning Authority and is or are available for inspection or purchase at a fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy at the offices of the Authority during its public opening hours and
- That a submission or observation in relation to the further information or revised plans may be made in writing to the Planning Authority on payment of the prescribed fee, not later than 2 weeks after receipt of the newspaper notice and site notice by the Planning Authority.

You are requested to submit the full page of the newspaper notice to the Planning Authority immediately following publication of this advertisement.

NOTE: Where a Planning Authority considers that the notice published does not adequately inform the public, the Authority may require the applicant to give such further notice in such a manner and in such terms as the authority may specify.

NOTE: In relation to a planning application accompanied by an EIS, a submission or observation may be made within 5 weeks of receipt of such notices by the Planning Authority.

5. Delete as appropriate.
6. Either the signature of the applicant or the signature and contact address of the person acting on behalf of the applicant should be inserted here.
7. The date that the notice is erected or fixed at the site should be inserted here.
