

### **Part 4 Summary of Charges:**

Charges will be exerted on a cost per linear metre of the road width. The current charges applicable are as follows (reviewed on an ongoing basis):

€25 per linear meter Grass Verge Roadsurfacing €5 per linear meter

#### **Important Notes:**

- 1. Consideration should be given to mole boring under the public road, where suitable. GWS can apply to the relevant Municipal District for a refund for any road crossings done using the mole bore method. Refunds will be given following a satisfactory inspection by the Municipal District.
- 2. If verge reinstatement is done in accordance with the relevant specification for reinstatement, the GWS can apply to the relevant Municipal District for 50% of the cost to open the verge to be refunded 12 months after the completion of works. Refunds will be given following a satisfactory inspection by the Municipal District.
- 3. These charges apply to longitudinal and transverse openings and shall be no more than 1m wide; where trench widths are greater an addition charge may be applied. The minimum charge for a road opening is €300.
- 4. Full width road reinstatement may be agreed/required by Offaly County Council in certain circumstances (e.g. narrow roads, roads with poor foundation in accordance with the Specification for the 'Reinstatement of Openings in National Roads'...
- 5. Contractors/companies must produce for inspection by the Council a Public Liability Insurance Policy with a limit of indemnity for any one accident of €6.35 million endorsed to indemnify the County Council against all costs, expenses, outlays and claims incurred in defending any proceedings by any party whose person or property is damaged because of this road opening. All reasonable precautions to avoid accidents should be taken by the "Road Opener" including adequate signs/lights, as per Chapter 8, such signs/lights to be maintained until permanent restoration has been carried out by Offaly County Council.
- 6. A miscellaneous fee may be required for road marking, informing the public if water needs to be turned off to make a connection, the cost of a road closure, etc.
- 7. Subsequent to discussion with the relevant Municipal District, multiple road openings may be applied for on one single application for a road opening licence.

#### **Part 5 General Conditions:**

- A Public Road, Footpath, Verge Opening may only be carried out under Licence by Offaly County Council.
- A Licence will expire 28 days from the date of grant of the permit.
- The Licencee must provide evidence of up to date Insurance which specifically covers the nature of the works being undertaken and specifically indemnifies Offaly County Council against all costs, expenses and outlays and claims as a result of the said works.
- The minimum level of indemnity required is: Public Liability €6.35 million Employers Liability €12.7 million (Minimum).
- Employers and Public Liability must be stand-alone polices which operate independently of any other Insurance Policy.
- Copy of the Licence must be kept on site at all times for inspection.
- · All works must be in compliance with the following legislation, regulations and guidelines:
  - o The Safety, Health & Welfare at Work Act 2005 (Health & Safety Authority (HSA)
  - o The Safety, Health & Welfare at Work (Construction) Regulations, 2006 2013 (HSA)
  - Chapter 8, Traffic Signs Manual (DoT 2010) NRA.
  - o Specifications for the reinstatement of openings in National Roads (NRA).
  - Guidelines for Opening, Backfilling and Reinstatement of Trenches in Public Roads –
     Department of Environment, Community & Local Government (DECLG).
  - o Recommendations for site development works in Housing Areas (DECLG)
  - o Guidance for the Control and Management of Traffic at Roadworks (NRA).
  - Code of Practice of avoiding Danger from overhead electricity lines (Electricity Supply Boards (ESB Networks).
  - Code of practice of avoiding Dangers from Underground Services (ESB Networks).
  - o Any other relevant legislation, regulations, guidelines and amendments thereof. Current NRA Advice notes on permanent road repair systems spec.

- (a) Accept responsibility for any accident, loss or damage which may occur to any person or property until the Director of Service/Area Engineer has certified that the works has been completed satisfactorily and
- (b) Indemnify Offaly Local Authorities against all costs, expenses and outlays incurred in defending any proceedings by an party whose person or property is so damaged and in this context, the GWS undertake to effect a Standard Public Liability Policy to cover the GWS liability and that of Offaly County Council for any accident up to €6.35 million and to produce this policy for inspection by Offaly County Council in advance of road opening.
