Part 4 Summary of Charges:

Charges will be exerted on a cost per sq. metre basis. While it would be a basic requirement of all road opening permits that trench widths are as narrow as possible, all trenches of 1 metre in width or less, shall be regarded as being 1 metre wide for the purpose of calculation of charges. For trenches of greater than 1 metre in width, the actual width will be assumed for calculation purposes. The current charges applicable are as follows (reviewed on an ongoing basis):-

Important Notes:

1. These charges apply to longitudinal and transverse openings. The minimum charge for a road opening is €300.
2. Consideration should be given to mole boring under the public road, where suitable. Applicants can apply to the relevant Municipal District for a refund for any road crossings done using the mole bore method. Refunds will be given following a satisfactory inspection
3. The Area Engineer will refund the refundable deposit following a satisfactory inspection. A waiting period of 12 months will apply from final reinstatement to ensure full consolidation of the trench before the deposit will be refunded. In the event that any work is not carried out to the satisfaction of Offaly County Council, the Council may carry out remedial works and deduct cost of same from deposit.
4. Full width road reinstatement may be agreed/required by Offaly County Council in certain circumstances (e.g. narrow roads, roads with poor foundation)
5. The insurance fee is payable only by applicants who are private individuals with no Public Liability Insurance policy to cover such works subject to the normal terms, conditions and exceptions of the Council's Public Liability policy. Contractors/companies must produce for inspection by the Council a Public Liability Insurance Policy with a limit of indemnity for any one accident of €6,350,000 endorsed to indemnify the County Council against all costs, expenses, outlays and claims incurred in defending any proceedings by any party whose person or property is damaged because of this road opening. All reasonable precautions to avoid accidents should be taken by the "Road Opener" including adequate signs/lights as per the requirements of Chapter 8, such signs/lights to be maintained until permanent restoration has been carried out by Offaly County Council.
6. A miscellaneous fee may be required for road marking, loss of paid parking or cost of a road closure, etc.

I agree to

- a). accept responsibility for any accident, loss or damage which may occur to any person or property, until the Director of Service/Area Engineer has certified that the work has been completed satisfactorily; and
- b). indemnify the Council against all costs, expenses and outlays incurred in defending any proceedings by any party whose person or property is so damaged, and in this context, I undertake to effect a Standard Public Liability Policy to cover my liability and that of the Council for any accident up to €6.35 million and to produce this policy for inspection by the County Council, in advance of road opening; or
- c). as a private individual who is not a company or contractor to pay Offaly County Council the sum of €100 so that such insurance cover can be adequately affected on my behalf. (See important notes 5.).

Part 5 General Conditions:

- A Public Road, Footpath, Verge Opening may only be carried out under Licence by Offaly County Council.
- A Licence will expire 28 days from the date of grant of the permit.
- The Licencee must provide evidence of up to date Insurance which specifically covers the nature of the works being undertaken and specifically indemnifies Offaly County Council against all costs, expenses and outlays and claims as a result of the said works.
- The minimum level of indemnity required is:
Public Liability €6.35 million
Employers Liability €12.7 million
- In the case of a private individual, who is not a company or contractor, a payment in the sum of €100 shall be paid to Offaly County Council so that such insurance cover can be adequately affected on their behalf.
- Employers and Public Liability must be stand-alone policies which operate independently of any other Insurance Policy.
- Copy of the Licence must be kept on site at all times for Inspection.
- All works must be in compliance with the following guidelines and regulations:-
