O'Connor Square.

The newly refurbished southern side of O'Connor Square is now open to the public. The newly refurbished plaza was opened on Friday evening last 08/11/19 and once again permits two-way traffic flows to and from the Tan-Yard to O'Connor square and provides access to new parking spaces on this side.

Work has now commenced on the northern side of O'Connor Square which when completed will provide the remainder of the planned car parking for the square while also providing a large pedestrian plaza.



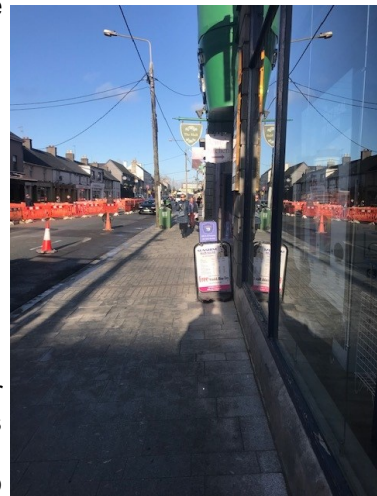
High Street.

The resurfacing of High Street was completed last week and High Street is now back open to two-way traffic permanently. The new road surface has been completed

from Moore Street down to the front of O'Connor square where it joins the new road running through O'Connor Square. In excess of 4,500m² of new road surface has been laid to date.

William Street.

The western side of William street has progressed this week with paving works progressing from the Patrick Street junction towards Harbour Street. All ground works and kerbing are completed this week to the Harbour St. Junction and the remainder of the paving will be in place on William Street by the end of November.



Traffic and Parking

The **First Hour Free** Parking initiative in both Texas Car Park and O'Neill Place Car park (rear of Spollens Pub) is ongoing for the duration of the works on William Street. The regular two way traffic system will be restored to William Street by the end of November.
