ROADS ACT 1993 - NOTICE OF DECISION TEMPORARY CLOSING OF THE ROAD NO. N62 AT CLOGHAN TD. SOUTH OF CLOGHAN, CO. OFFALY TO BOOLINARIG LITTLE TD. NORTH OF BIRR TOWN (11.2km - Or Part Thereof).

This Council gives notice of its decision to close, temporarily, the following road in accordance with section 75 of the Roads Act 1993 (S.I. 197 of 1993) and the Roads Regulation 1994.

THE ROAD NO. N62 AT CLOGHAN TD. SOUTH OF CLOGHAN, CO. OFFALY TO BOOLINARIG LITTLE TD. NORTH OF BIRR TOWN (11.2km Or Part Thereof)

Vehicular access will be available for the local residents / landowners via detour but access from Cloghan TD & Boolinarig Little TD north of Birr Town will not be available.

Alternative routes are as follows:

Northbound Diversion Route: Traffic travelling North on N62 will divert at Birr onto Traffic Management Diversion Route (Pound Street via L-70065 onto Taylors Cross via R-439 onto Cloghan Village via R438) to continue

Southbound Diversion Route: Traffic travelling South on N62 will divert south of Cloghan Village onto Traffic Management Diversion Route (Cloghan Village via R438 onto Taylors Cross via R-439 onto Pound Street via L-70065) to continue South on N62.

HGV Diversion Route: via Tullamore, M6 Junction 8 to Junction 5 and N52 northbound and southbound.

All diversion routes will be sign posted. The road will be closed for a three month period (or part thereof) beginning in the month of July 2023. The road closure is necessary to facilitate the removal and replacement of road pavement and accommodation works. A map indicating the location of the road closure and diversions to be put in place may be viewed on the local authority's website at www.offaly.ie
